

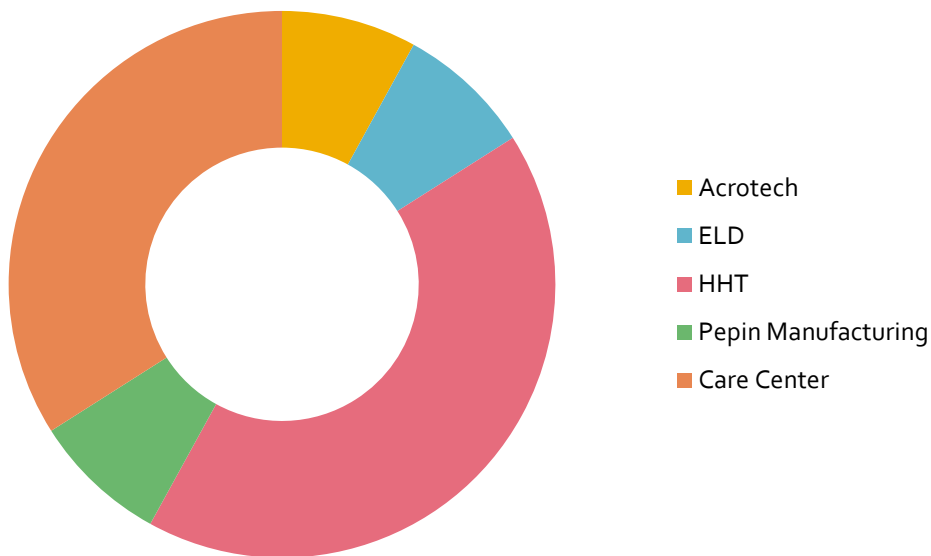

# Lake City Employees Respond to Survey

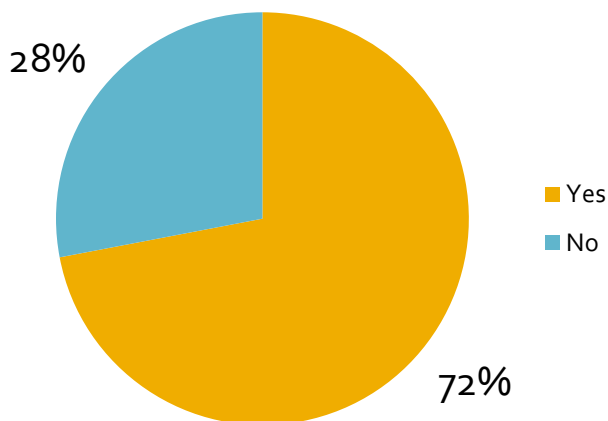
## Survey Responses Sources



- Of approximately 950 employees at these 5 employers, 18% (or 171) are estimated to have children 5 and under.
- 50 employees completed the surveys for a very respectable response rate of approximately 29%

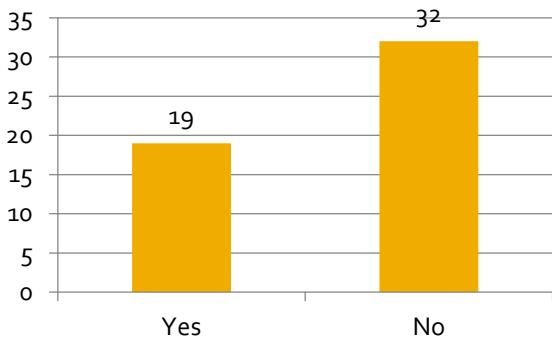

work?**



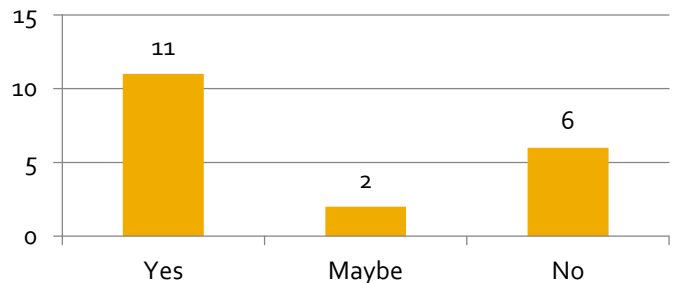
- In addition, 40 of 50 respondents said that they know someone who wants to work but cannot because of child care issues primarily to availability and cost.

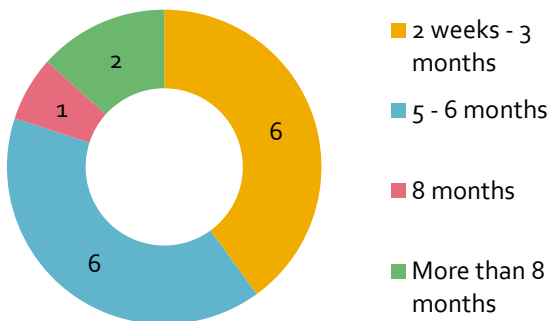
Do you use child care in Lake City?



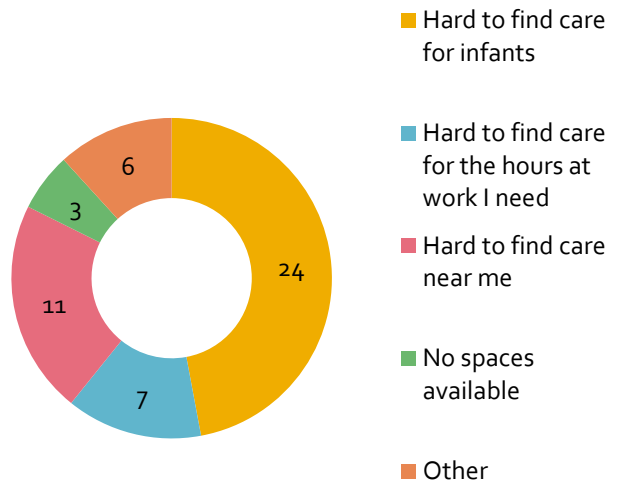
If you don't use child care in Lake City, would you if there were available spaces?



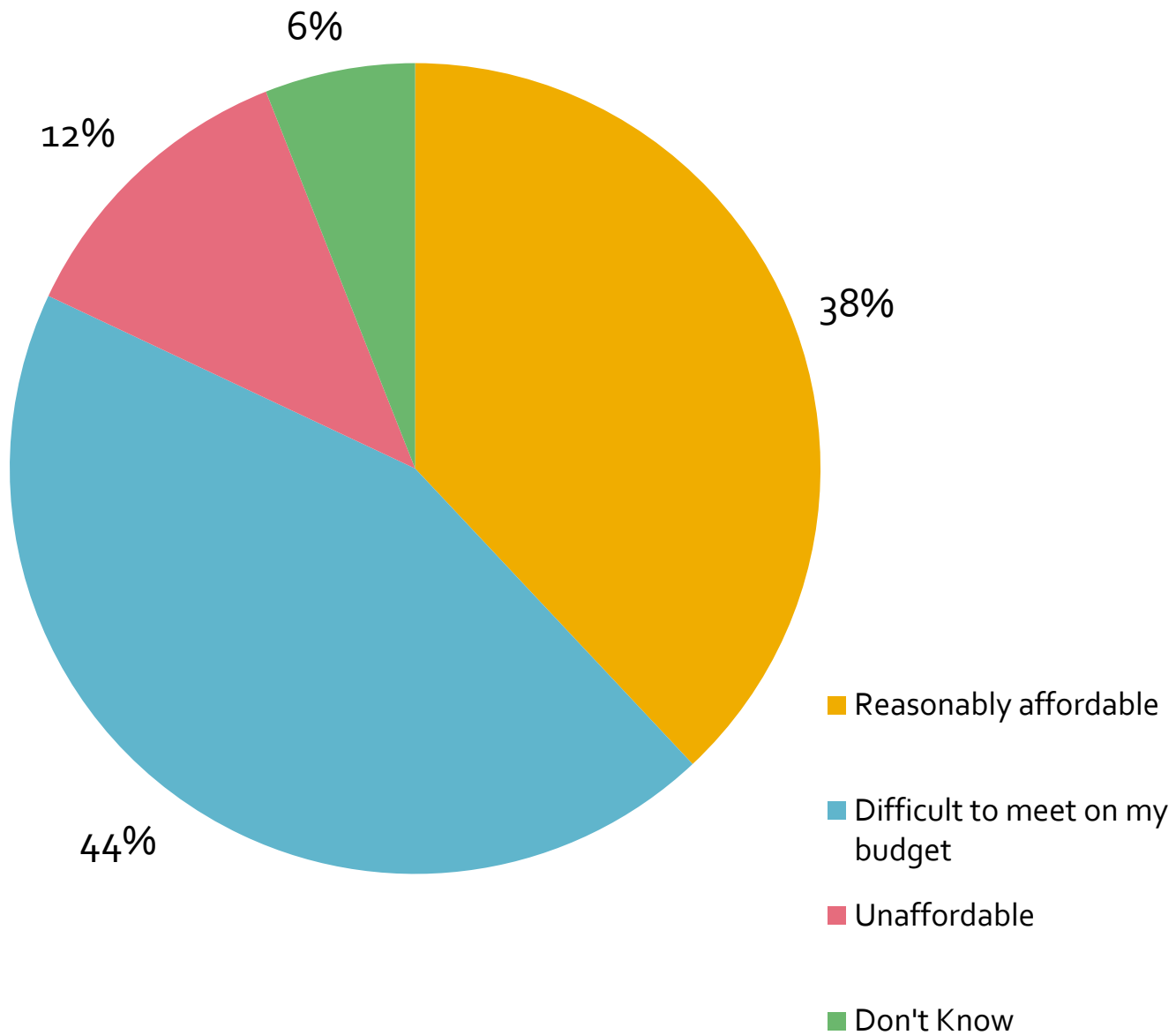
If yes, how long did it take for you to find child care?
